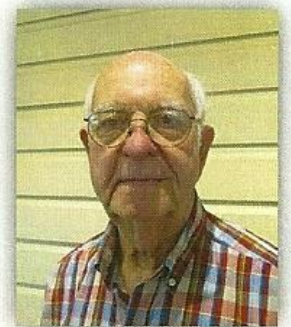
Thursday, August 9, 6:30-8:00 p.m.

The Format: A thoughtful presentation will be shared on a particular topic, followed by responders and group dialogue, to discern its resonance with vibrant Christian faith.

Synopsis: This talk will begin with the history and importance of Euclidean geometry. The second part will present an English novel, *Flatland*, written by Edwin Abbott in 1884. The characters in *Flatland* are geometric figures and the setting is in a Euclidean plane. We will take an imaginary tour through the dimensions of Euclidean geometry from zero to three, peek through the keyhole into the fourth dimension and perhaps find a place for God!
