The Format: A thoughtful presentation will be shared, followed by two invited responders and then open group dialogue, to discern its resonance with vibrant Christian faith.

<u>Presentation Synopsis:</u> Genesis 2-11 are the most read and least understood of all the passages of Scripture. Understood as Semitic history beginning about 7,000 years ago, they resonate with the history of the ancient Near East. Taken as human history they make no sense at all. In this talk we will examine the extra-biblical evidence that establishes a reason to view the inspired text in a new light, one in which we can place our confidence.

Speaker Biography: After an Air Force career with well over 100 combat missions in Viet Nam, Dick Fischer accepted Christ in 1984, founded Genesis Proclaimed Association, and began a quest for verification that the Genesis text could be inspired truth despite anthropological evidence that confirms human beings have a six million-year history.
